OBSTETRICAL & GYNAECOLOGICAL LAB:

This Laboratory is for Midwifery Experience and is equipped to develop skills handling normal and complicated delivery. The students gain skill in imparting comprehensive maternity care. Here a student learn the basic skills of Maternity And Child Health Nursing Prior To The Clinical Area. The Lab Contains Various Obstetrical Chart's related to Antenatal, Intranatal and Postnatal Care, Including Models to practice the conduct of labor.
